PLEASE LEAVE ME HOME IF...

More than 1 time in the past 24 hours or continues to feel nauseous	Temperature of 100.4	More than 1 loose stool in the past 24 hours	Until you have been treated with lice shampoo	Drainage from one or both eyes	Unusually tired/ uncomfortable stuffed up feeling and/or continuous runny nose	With fever	Red, sore throat with patches on tonsils, swollen glands, fever and/or rash	Hospital stay or emergency room visit

TO RETURN TO SCHOOL I MUST...

Be free from vomiting for 24 hours	Be fever free without the use of fever reducing medication for 24 hours (i.e. Tylenol, Motrin or Advil)	Be free from diarrhea for 24 hours	Have been treated with lice shampoo (i.e. RID, NIX)	Have eyes that are not draining and have completed 24 hours of treatment	Be fever free without the use of fever reducing medication for 24 hours (i.e. Tylenol, Motrin or Advil)	Be fever free without the use of fever reducing medication for 24 hours (i.e. Tylenol, Motrin or Advil)	Be fever free without the use of fever reducing medication for 24 hours. To have completed 24 hours of treatment. MD note	Have a doctor's note permitting return to school along with any special instructions
